We're back...and ready to go!!!



We're continuing our regular monthly meetings on Saturday January 12 at 11 AM in the UNITED WAY OF MIAMI-DADE building located at 3250 SW 3 Ave. (Yes, that's right there at Five Points - within walking distance of the Vizcaya MetroRailStation.) We also have use of the parking garage, right next door. (See page 2 for map and directions.) Following our traditional format, we'll start with a meet-and-greet session and then go to announcements, an educational presentation **MINERAL FLUORESCENCE** – **how certain minerals respond to ultra-violet light.** (Please feel free to bring some of your own specimens to test under the UV source.) Then we'll have our usual Q & A, door prizes, and light refreshments.

The next tri-county picnic will be at TY Park in Broward County on Sunday Jan 27- pavilion # 9 from10am to 4pm. This get-together of the Palm Beach, Broward, and Miami-Dade Clubs will feature food – fun - fabulous values / minerals – gems – artisan jewelry. It's a potluck event – the three clubs supply meat entrees, and theattendees bring side dishes and/or desserts for all to share. Members will have gems, minerals, jewelry to swap or sell - we'll have Bingo and raffles with hobby-related prizes. Don't miss it!

Slowly, but surely, we are revitalizing our Club. One of our missions is to share our "how to" expertise with our fellow members. We made a start this past Fall. Dianne Mielke started a beading "mentoring session" in her home for several of our members – averaging one weekend session a month. Those ladies love it!

And we're currently on track to re-establish our own lapidary workshop - in which we can set up stone cutting and polishing equipment as well as a traditional jewelry artisan workbench. The cabbing machine and accessories (as well as a Dremel tool station) are already in place. From the North – take I-95 South to Exit 1A (Rickenbacker Causeway/Key Biscayne). Make a right turn at the traffic light onto SW 25 Road and go 3 blocks to Coral Way (SW 3 Ave) and turn left. Follow Coral Way to SW 32 Road and turn right – then immediately turn right into United Way Parking Garage (free parking). Exit garage on foot and cross SW 32 Road to main entrance to UNITED WAY on Coral Way.

From the South – Take US 1 (South Dixie Highway) North past SW 17 Ave and make the next left turn at SW 16 Ave/SW 3 Ave and follow SW 3 Ave to Five Points (Coral Way and SW 12 Ave). At the traffic light, turn left onto SW 12 Ave – go to the end of the block and turn right onto SW 32 Road. Make left turn at last driveway (parking garage entrance - free covered parking). Exit garage on foot and cross SW 32 Road to main entrance to UNITED WAY on Coral Way.

From VIZCAYA METRORAIL STATION (on foot) – exit station parking lot to SW 32 Road and walk 3 blocks to Coral Way. Cross Coral Way (carefully) and walk to UNITED WAY main entrance.


